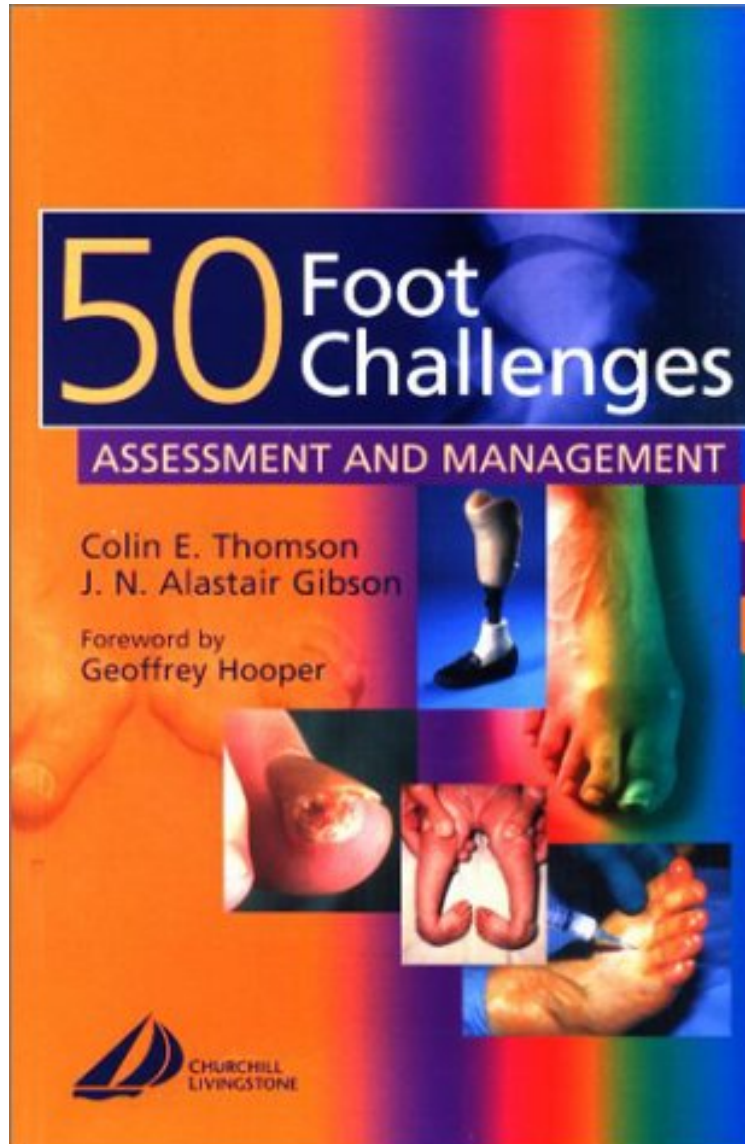

The questions aim to test the reader's knowledge of the relevant treatment as well as the pathology. Explanatory answers expanding on the information already presented are given on the verso page of the illustration section. The format is intended to introduce the reader to the clinical assessment process and to introduce students and newly qualified practitioners to those conditions which they are most commonly going to encounter in the clinic. This unique text provides a much-needed, full-color guide to podiatry. A quick clinical reference and a useful self-assessment tool, it encourages learning by reasoning. It addresses clinical assessment - a crucial area of learning. Quality, full-colour photographs provide examples of conditions that readers may not have viewed first hand, but will be expected to treat in practice.
