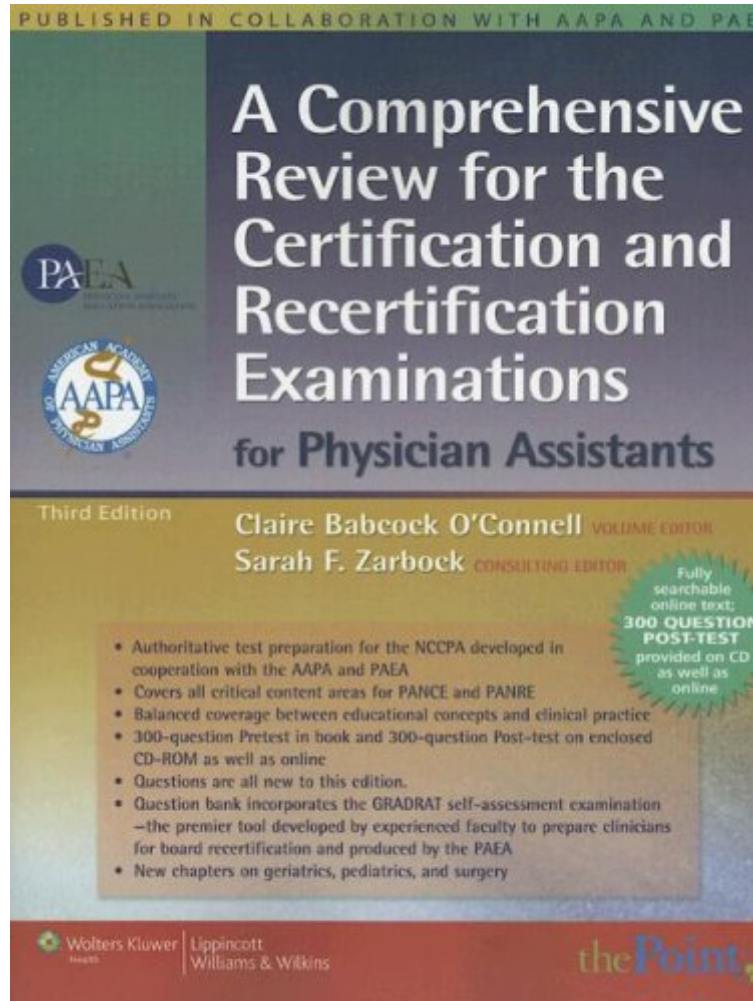

bad book for the money. I used this book to study for my PANRE in Sept. 2010. It surpasses the previous edition because it had a section on infectious disease and a section on pediatrics. It also had new sections on Orthopedics and Trauma, but this was not needed for me. This was the first time I took the PANRE since certifying by the PANCE in 2004. I scored about 200 points higher on the PANRE than the PANCE. I am not saying that this is due completely to this book (6 years of experience likely added to this), but this was pretty much the only book I studied.
