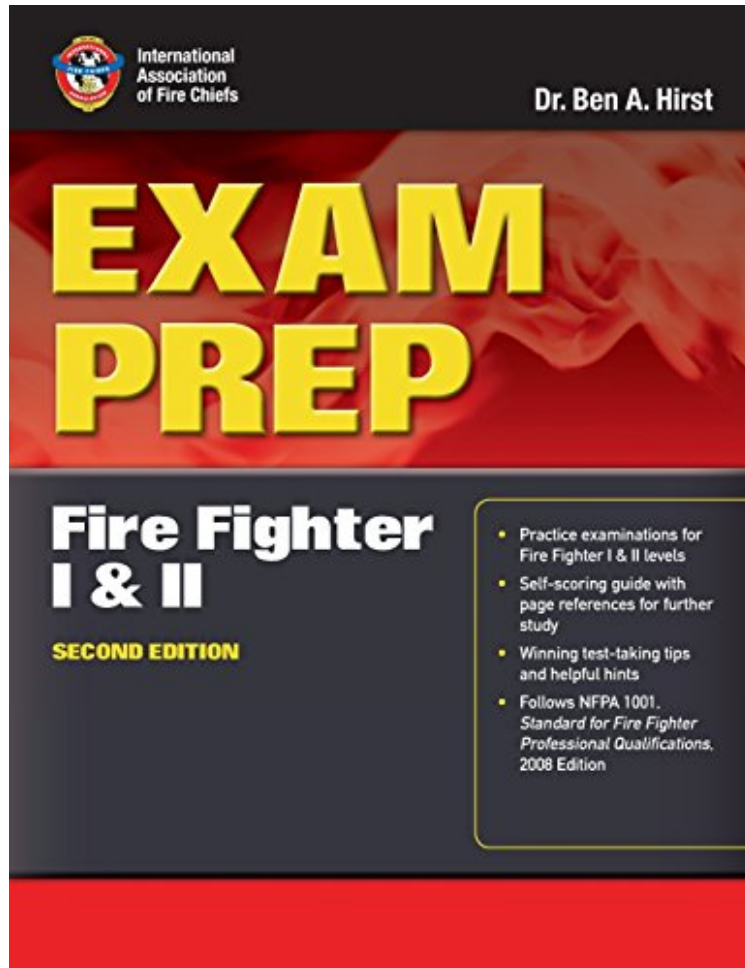

The book contains the answer key that also gives you the reference (book/page) to the correct answer. There is a process that book outlines that I think is a good one and should be followed. My issues: I found at least one incorrect answer (Minor issue). While the questions in this book are good and cover a wide range of material, there really weren't that many questions that helped me with the exams that I took in the State of Kansas (KFRTI). This book may have more applicability to other state exams than mine.
