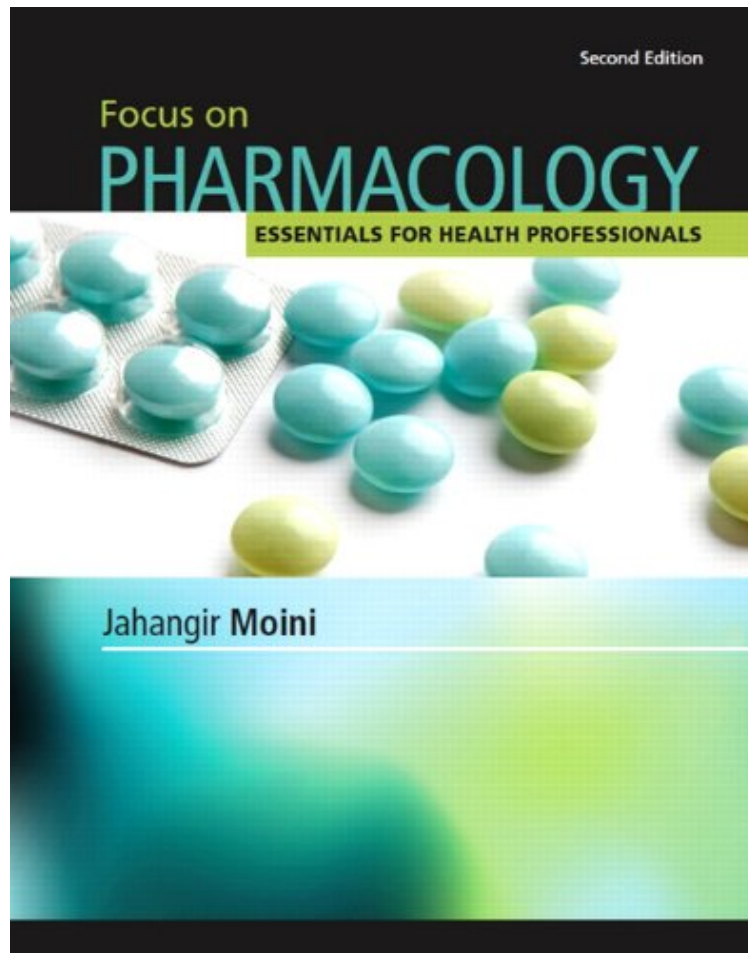

By scraigwI have to wonder who edited this book, because there are so many obvious mistakes and inconsistencies. From simple things like not taking the label lines off of diagrams even when there is no label for the line (e.g. 7 on fig 26.1), to much more important things like content that contradicts itself or incorrect answer keys, or grammar that sounds like it was translated from someplace else in a few instances. There are quite a lot of those more important mistakes, unfortunately. I could imagine it being worse, but not very much worse. Poor explanation of the different classes of drugs, bringing up drugs in the text which aren't addressed in the tables, straight up unclear discussion of some of the A P concepts. This is the stuff the book is supposed to be clarifying and teaching. The format/layout is also lackluster in general.
