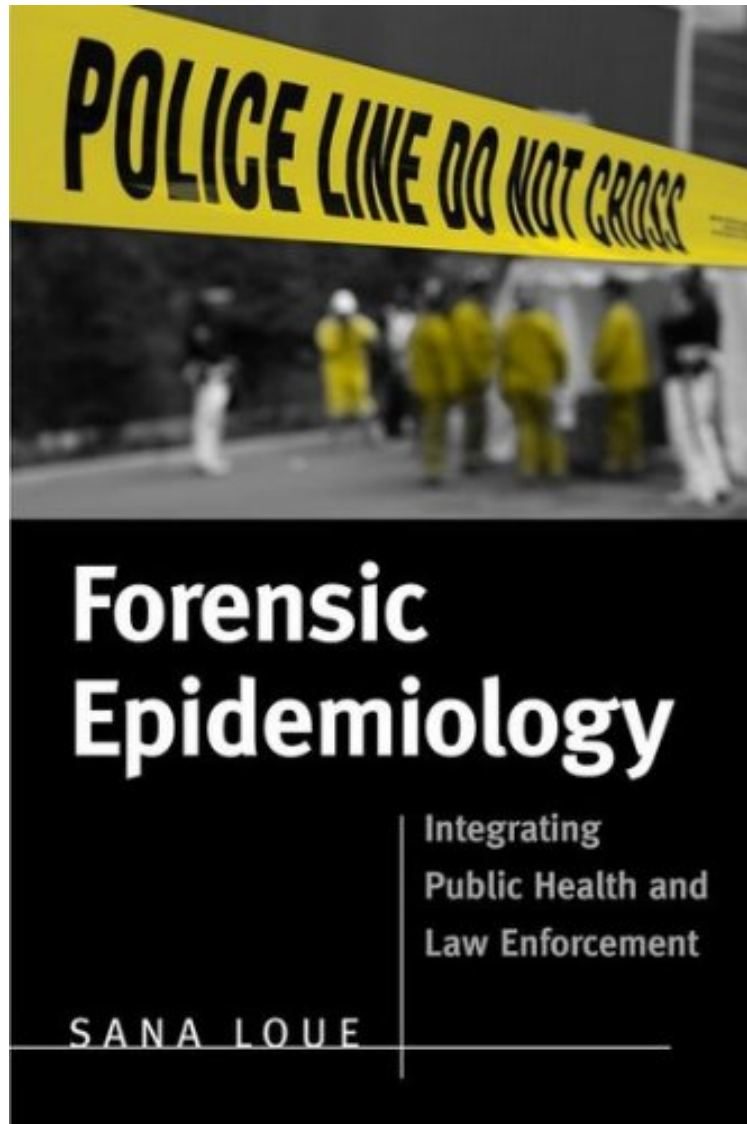

disappointed to find that there were no references to CDC's National Violent Death Reporting System (NVDRS), or its predecessor, Harvard's National Violent Incident Surveillance System (NVISS). NVDRS has been arguably the most important development in the last 20 years with regards to the integration of public health and law enforcement. I would hope that later editions of this book would be able to note the critical role played by NVDRS. While I'm sure that there is much to be gleaned from this comprehensive text, I do find it concerning that this book failed to reference one of the most illustrative, successful, and current examples integrating public health and law enforcement. Because of this lapse, I cannot help but wonder what else might be missing. Given the cost, and my concern about the lack of mention of NVDRS, I chose not to purchase this book.
