I use this book at Columbia College where I teach a Case Management Class in our Human Services program and it is perhaps the most realistic and down to earth text I use. One quirk, not a flaw but something to be aware of, is that there has been no attempt to make the chapters the same length. That is a normal practice for most text books so you would cover one chapter a week - or something like that.
