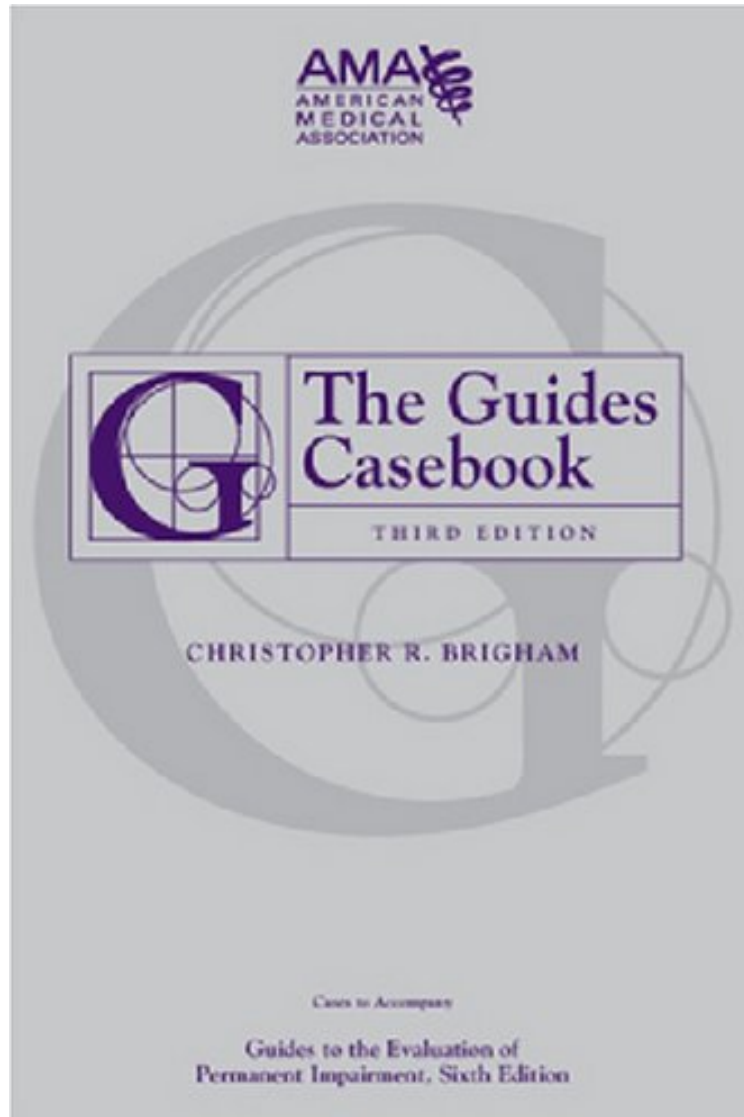

Guides. There are three additional cases in the third edition as compared to the second, and several more than in the first edition. There is a thorough and very helpful discussion of mental trauma injuries (which were not discussed in the first edition) and of RSD/CRPS (which changes from edition to edition).
